TARAS SHEVCHENKO CENTENNIAL

WHEREAS the high principles of mankind are to be achieved only when every nation of the world would have men and women who will be ready to sacrifice themselves for their fulfillment, and

WHEREAS Taras Shevchenko, the great Ukrainian poet was such a man who fought for the humanitarian ideals, and

WHEREAS this is the Taras Shevchenko Centennial Year, and

WHEREAS Canadians of Ukrainian origin abide and live in the spirit of Shevchenko's ideals and thereby greatly contributed to the progress of Canada, and

WHEREAS 1961 is the 70th anniversary of the Ukrainian settlement in Canada,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Stephen Juba, Mayor of the City of Winnipeg, in the Province of Manitoba, do hereby proclaim the days of July 8th, 9th and 10th, as the Shevchenko Memorial Days to give thought to the importance of the universal ideals of democracy, freedom and justice for which Taras Shevchenko lived and died a martyr, and which are to be perpetuated.
