Proclamation

WHEREAS Wycliffe Bible Translator Dr. Harland Kerr has come to our city to tell us about translating the New Testament into the Wiru language;

AND WHEREAS the Wiru Tribe of New Guinea was one of the 2,000 isolated tribes of the world which had no written language;

AND WHEREAS 2,500 members of Wycliffe Bible Translators who deserve our encouragement are now working in 250 languages in 23 countries of the world to give God's word to hitherto forgotten people in their mother tongue;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Stephen Juba, and the Council of the City of Winnipeg, in the Province of Manitoba, do hereby proclaim this day the 15th day of October, 1971 as:

BIBLE TRANSLATION DAY

and join the Christian leaders of this City in recognizing during their appearance in Winnipeg the great work of Dr. Harland Kerr of the Wycliffe Bible Translators.
