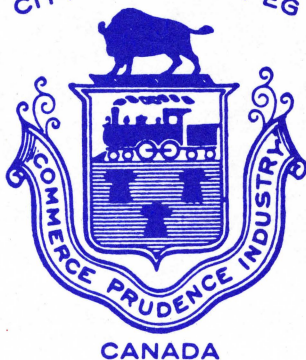

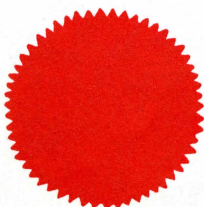
AND WHEREAS it devotes thousands of hours of service each year in the performance of many aspects of community endeavor and in support of worthwhile causes;

AND WHEREAS its emphasis on spiritual values and tenets of democratic heritage is impressed constantly upon hundreds of young men and women;


