
Of Court 16, Park Sone, Chappenham. Wiltslime England. Dear Mayor Juba I have great pleasure in informing you that I have despatched the badge today which I promised to donate to your city when I was in Winnepeg earlier this year I trust that you well receive it in good condition Permit me to explain the history of this budge. When the Great War broke out in 1914 there were four regiments in the cuty of Winnegay The mayor of that time (whose name I believe was Waugh) decided to form a regiment belonging to Die cetig He took a company from each

of the four regiments and formed the a bugler in the YOTH. Commerons I become a member of A Company. after severing 23 months in France as a bandsman and Battallion runner 9 became ill with TB. and sleeping sukness I spent 10 months in English hospitals followed by 5 mostles in Ninette Sanitorum. after this I was discharged from the army and returned to my relations in England. Whilst in hospital at Basingstoke in England I learnt embroidery, and made this badge for which my wife's uncle made the frame. I have kept this badge of the regiment ever since. as I am now 74, I would like to present it to the city in memory of this

. regiment which became famous in France during that terrible war I have attacked my cap badge and greations buttons which I work in france. I enclose a photograph of myself taken in 1914 in my hospital clothes Thankyon for the dighter you kindly game me when I marted the city Hall. I remain yours faithfully Herbert # Clauk
