WHEREAS October 6th, 1971, is Election Day in Greater Winnipeg and it is desirable that as many Citizens as possible exercise their franchise;

AND WHEREAS a suggestion that all the Churches of Winnipeg ring their bells hourly during the day, or at 11.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m., whichever they so desire, to bring to the attention of the people the importance of casting their ballot, has been agreed to by a great number of Churches;

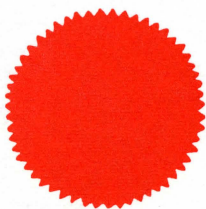
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Stephen Juba, Mayor of the City of Winnipeg, in the Province of Manitoba do hereby proclaim Wednesday, October 6th, 1971 as:

and that all Winnipeg Churches be urged to ring their bells on that day to bring to the attention of all Citizens of the Greater Winnipeg area that it is their democratic right and privilege to vote for the candidate of their choice.
