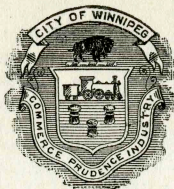
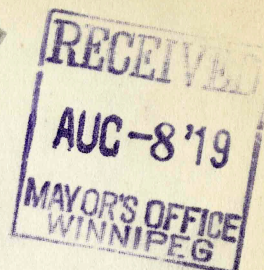

Dear Sir:

As instructed by you, I beg to submit a list of the food-stuffs destroyed at the City Incinerator, from June 26th, 1919 to July 31st, 1919, inclusive, together with a similar list covering the period between May 15th, 1918 and June 31st, 1918, for comparison.

It will be observed in 1918 for the period mentioned, there were 20 tons, 1,550 lbs. destroyed, and in 1919, 60 tons, 1,400 lbs. In addition there were large quantities of food-stuffs burnt on the Nuisance Ground during the 1919 strike, the estimated amount being 186 tons, 1,700 lbs., of which a report is also attached. It would appear that the increase in the destruction of food at the present time is entirely due to the dislocation of business caused by the walk-out of employees, as we have not received so much material to destroy in previous years.

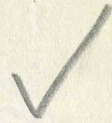
