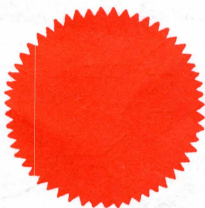
AND WHEREAS Winnipeg offers an impressive variety of leisure -time programs and facilities for citizens of all ages;
