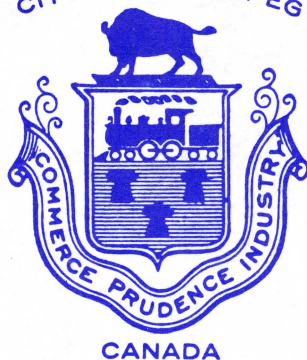

AND WHEREAS a large number of Americans will be in Winnipeg to attend the Centennial C.B. Jamboree and other functions;

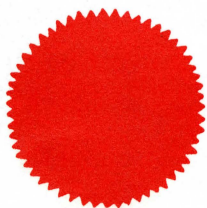
AND WHEREAS due to our feelings of kinship and understanding for our neighbours from the south in this commemoration of their founding day;
