Proclamation

WHEREAS the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religious belief is fundamental to a free and democratic social order;

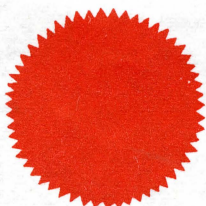
AND WHEREAS it is essential that Governments, organizations and private citizens strive to promote the spirit of understanding, respect, tolerance and friendship in matters of religious belief and practice;

AND WHEREAS the religious institutions of the City of Winnipeg fulfill a vital role in promoting spiritual and moral values within our community, making it desirable for each citizen to give his full support to the Church of his choice;

AND WHEREAS the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada is commemorating in Winnipeg the 50th Anniversary of the Establishment of its Hierarchy with a Provincial Synod and its First Eucharistic Congress;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Stephen Juba, Mayor of the City of Winnipeg, do hereby enjoin upon each citizen to participate fully in his own Church, and I do particularly urge all our citizens who are members of the Ukrainian Catholic Church to take an active part in the commemoration of the 50th Anniversary of the Establishment of its Hierarchy in Canada to be held in Winnipeg from June 28th to July 1st, 1962.
